Gruda – A nearby village with a museum on textile arts & a gallery with silk making

Croatia is east of Italy on the Adriatic sea, is a land of ancient ruins, gorgeous sunsets, smiling faces and stunning natural beauty! Some find it their favorite place on earth.

The Cavtat (sounds like tsovtot) waterfront is stunning. Walking a wide promenade that circles the entire peninsula, you'll arrive back to the town center. Several fine restaurants flank the waterfront and the village center has a bakery, bank, small grocery and post office.

Our modern villa, overlooking the Cavtat bay is made of white stone. It's a quarter mile walk downhill to the waterfront. Or a bus can take you there.

Our classroom, the deck and bedrooms are up a flight of beautiful stone steps. Accommodations are simple, clean and comfortable. Each room has a bathroom with a small shower.

The villa includes a shared kitchen with stove, dishwasher, three refrigerators and ample cupboard space.
