



TO GET HERE

From downtown: take Hwy 30, pass under the St. Johns Bridge, after the Sauvie Island stoplight, the next stoplight will be Cornelius Pass Rd.

Go left on Cornelius Pass Rd about 1 ¹/₄ miles. Turn right on Sheltered Nook Rd. (marked with "T").

From the south: take Hwy 26 to the Cornelius Pass northbound exit. Turn left on Sheltered Nook (marked with a T sign and blink lights).

Follow Sheltered Nook (6 tenths mile) and turn left.

Go to the bottom of the hill (1 tenth mile). There's an aqua ranch home to the left, a row of mailboxes on right. Pavement ends (see map).

Follow the straightest road up a steep hill (1 tenth mile). You'll pass a brick home (**B**) and log home (**L**) on the left. Next you'll see a grey house straight ahead in a clearing — it's not ours.

Keep going straight up - our drive angles to the left up above the log home (L). There's a **RENE.ART** sign at the top just above where you go left.

Follow the lane on up to our house. The drive is paved at the top & curved so stay to the left (out of the ditch) for best traction.

If you miss our drive at the sign, there's just one house above ours, the one you see as you drive up the gravel hill. If that happens, turn around at the top and go all the way down to the bottom pavement where you can turn around and have another go at it.

A 4-wheel drive vehicle is best on our steep drive. But most vehicles can make it up if you just don't stop on the steep grade! If you're worried, carpool — or call me from the mailboxes and I'll come drive you up. Park in the back by the cement wall. You can unload first by the sidewalk. Classroom entry is under the deck and past the magnolia tree.
